Pros & Cons of Cloning

- Pros: Keeps beloved traits alive, emotional comfort, genetic continuity for special needs (e.g., service dogs).
- Cons: Sky-high costs (\$50K+), ethical issues with surrogates, potential health risks from cloning process.

Pros & Cons of Adoption

- Pros: Saves a life, promotes genetic diversity for better health, affordable, builds unique bonds.
- Cons: Unknown background, possible adjustment time, behavioral surprises to train through.

Key Questions to Ask Yourself

- Am I driven by grief, or ready for a new chapter with a rescue?
- Can that cloning budget help more dogs through donations or adoptions?
- How do I feel about the welfare of surrogate moms in cloning?
- Is a genetic copy what I want, or the adventure of a unique pup's personality?
- Have I chatted with a vet about long-term health for clones vs. mixes?
